In the project INCONET - Partnership "Regional shortage of skilled labour European concepts" were realised these activities yet: On the 1st meeting in Miskolc /Hungary/ - 1.- 4.10.2008 were disccussed the practacal issues, was provided a plan and tasks in general and specifical form for each institution and each meeting, involvement of associated partners, were disccussed the methods and procedures by implementation of tasks and projects till the evaluation and dissemination, assembly, summary and exchange of mutual experience and knowledge to find and clarify the most lacked branches of each regions. On the 2nd meeting in Angermünde /Germany/- 11.- 14.2.2009 was performed a comparision of the most critical regional locations in shortage of the specialists and experts, presentation of each institutions and entrepreneurial subjects, labor offices, personnel agency and the other institutions for issue of the strategic plan of personnel developing /exchange of experience to projects of each country/, was taken place a workshop to this problem by quite huge participation. On the 3rd meeting in Teplice /Czech Republic/ - 13.- 16.5.2009 was exchanged the experience of a new and alternative educational methods to ensure of qualification of workers and staff in factories /e-learning, activities supported by IT technologies and further additional activities to employment, additional qualifications of workplaces, in realized workshop by participation of entrepreneurial subjects were performed the examples of the good practice for these branches.
